

Stay Safer Together AUTEUR VISITOR POLICY

For the safety of our team and our guests, Auteur Wines has the following policies for visitors. By entering our tasting room, you agree to abide by the following COVID-19 directives.

1. If you are experiencing any covid-like symptoms, we will kindly ask you to reschedule your wine experience with us for the safety of our team and their families. We will request anyone experiencing symptoms to be excused and appreciate your understanding.
2. Visitors who are currently experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19, must not enter our facility. These symptoms include cough, fever over 100.4 degrees, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, or recent loss of taste or smell.
3. Please do not engage in physical contact with our employees. As much as we miss hugs and handshakes, we are still being cautious during this time of uncertainty. We appreciate if you please maintain 6 feet of space with those not in your immediate party.
4. Guests may remove their face covering once seated and once wine service has begun and while at your assigned area.
5. Please wear your mask when going to the bathroom. Please wash and sanitize your hands upon arrival as well as after coughing, sneezing or blowing your nose or using the bathroom. Sanitizing products are available for your use.
6. Please cooperate with any verbal instructions provided by our employees to ensure a safe and pleasurable experience for all.

We thank you for your assistance in keeping all our guests and employees safer together.

Exception: Health and safety reasons

If you have a physical, intellectual, or developmental disability that prevents you from wearing a face covering, you do not have to wear one. If you are deaf and use facial and mouth movements as part of communication, you can remove your mask while communicating. Anyone who has trouble breathing, or is not able to take off a face covering without help, should not wear one. You do not have to wear a face covering if you have a letter from a medical professional saying you do not need to wear one because of your condition.
